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
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

German Textile Export DE --> UA




German Textile Import UA --> DE

02 – Free Trade Agreement EU-Ukraine

EU-Ukraine Deep and Comprehensive Free Trade Area

November 2014 Provisional application Association Agreement

January 2016 Provisional application DCFTA

September 2017 Entry into force

DCFTA means...

- ... mutual tariff elimination
- ... striving for more efficient customs procedures
- ...gradual approximation of Ukrainian legislation, rules, standards to those of the EU

EU-Ukraine Deep and Comprehensive Free Trade Area

Industrial Goods

EU removed 94.7% of the tariff lines, gradual elimination periods for a few goods

minerals - 2019
chemicals - 2021
fertilisers - 2023
wood products - 2021
footwear - 2021
copper articles - 2021
aluminium articles - 2023
cars and most motor vehicles - 2023

Ukraine removed 49.2% of industrial products tariffs. 2023: 96% tariff lines duty free for EU products

minerals - 2023 organic chemicals - 2019 fertilisers - 2019 rubber tyres - 2021 leather articles - 2021 textiles such as headgear - 2019

Ukraine's motor vehicle sector will also enjoy a transitional period lasting until 2026, a result of negotiations agreed upon at the WTO in 2008.





The new PEM zone

- Liberalised Rules of Origin
- Cumulation / duty free cooperation possible between 24 PEM countries as of 1st January 2025
- More possibilities to source and trade duty-free.
- More countries granting market access for goods made in Ukraine.
